

Associate Uniform

To reflect the flexible nature of this role, Associates can either wear the uniform choices below or opt not to wear uniform if they feel that is appropriate. Associates should chat to their Captain about this matter.

Ceremonial Uniform

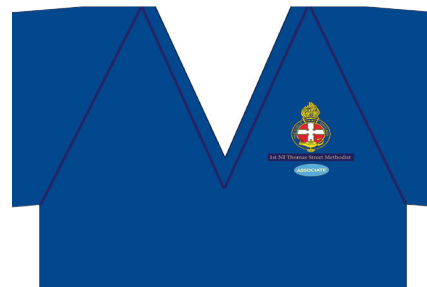
- Navy GB skirt (knee-length);
- White open neck short sleeved GB blouse;
- Navy GB 'V' neck sweatshirt with GB Crest embroidered on left side and company title (gold lettering on navy) directly underneath and in line with the point of the 'V';
- Associate section badge worn on GB sweatshirt, directly underneath company title and in line with the bottom of the GB Crest;
- Armband (if they have come up through the ranks and wish to wear it);
- Plain black tights (up to 70 denier - providing there is uniformity within the section);
- Plain black flat shoes; and
- Navy ribbon or plain navy elastic bobble to tie back long hair.



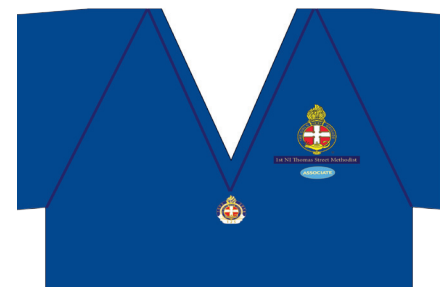
Associate Ceremonial Uniform

Working uniform

- Navy GB track bottoms with GB Crest or plain navy track bottoms;
- White open neck short sleeved GB blouse;
- Navy GB 'V' neck sweatshirt (as stated above);
- Associate section badge on GB sweatshirt (as stated above);
- Plain white ankle socks;
- Plain white trainers or white PE slippers; and
- White ribbon or plain white elastic bobble to tie back long hair.

PE Uniform

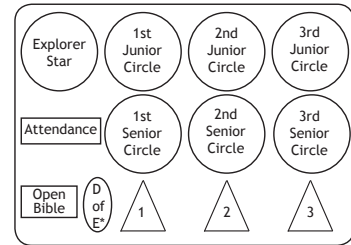
- Navy GB tunic (as stated above);
- White open neck short sleeved GB blouse;
- Navy long legged pants;
- Plain white ankle socks;
- White PE slippers laced with ribbon or tape; and
- White ribbon or white fastenings to tie back long hair.



PE Uniform

Wearing Associate Awards

- Centenary Badge or (from Sept 2018) 125th Anniversary Badge *is to be worn on the point of the 'V' on the GB Sweatshirt*; and
- Endurance Award, if applicable, to be worn on right side of sweatshirt beside award ribbon.



Associate armband, prior to achieving the Brigader Brooch

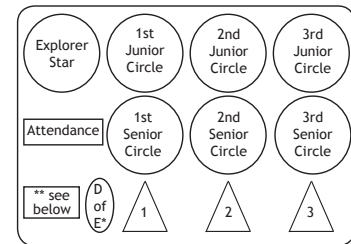
*Bronze or Silver DofE Brooch only
- remove when Gold is achieved.

Associate that has come up through the ranks:

- Associates wear their awards on an armband which is worn on left sleeve of GB sweatshirt.

Positioning of badges after Brigader Brooch has been awarded:

- Awards are worn on armband with the exception of the Open Bible Award;
- An awards ribbon is to be worn on the GB sweatshirt, on right side of the 'V', level with top of the GB Crest;
- Transfer Open Bible Award from armband to ribbon;
- Endurance Award, if applicable, worn on right side of GB sweatshirt beside award ribbon; and
- Awards to be placed on ribbon in the following order:
 - Open Bible Award,
 - Brigader Brooch to be replaced by Queen's Award when gained (Brigader Brooch can be transferred to bottom left corner of armband),
 - Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award, if gained (remove Silver Award from armband).



Associate armband after achieving the Brigader Brooch

*Bronze or Silver DofE Brooch only
- remove when Gold is achieved.

**Brigader Brooch may be worn here after Queen's Award is achieved.

Associate that has not come up through the ranks:

- An awards ribbon is to be worn on right side of the 'V' on GB sweatshirt, level with top of GB Crest;
- Awards to be placed on ribbon in the following order:
 - Open Bible Award,
 - Attendance Award,
 - Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award, if gained.
