for a short block e.g. holiday period

Habitat ReStore, the charity's social enterprise which tackles poverty helping local people access low-cost materials DIY and Home Improvement materials, supports skills and employability training for vulnerable groups and diverts tons of reusable material from landfill. What will you be doing:

ReStore volunteers are involved in a wide range of tasks as follows:

 On the Sales Floor – greeting customers, answering questions, helping with purchases

• Till – operating till

• Collections in the Habitat lorry

Processing incoming donated items in Donation Centre

• Building furniture or kitchens in store

The skills you need: Ability to work as part of a team. Punctuality. Good communication

skills. Enthusiasm for Habitat's mission and the work of ReStore.

No need to be a DIY expert!

Notes: All the training necessary and background information is provided.

All new volunteers attend an induction training session before starting, further on-the-job training is provided as needed.
